

Women's Overnight Paddle Camping Trip Long Pond in the St. Regis Wilderness Area

Solo canoeing, waterside camping, time with loons, optional small peak hike from a boat access only trailhead

**Saturday & Sunday
August 13 & 14, 2011**

we invite you to join us for a couple of days in the St. Regis Wilderness area. We've got the perfect boats for exploring this area, the lightest boats in the woods actually at 12-17 lbs. We will meet in Tupper Lake (at our Raquette River location) Saturday morning (8:00 AM) to pack for the trip. Hornbeck solo canoes, paddling gear, camping gear (excluding sleeping bag), cooking gear and meals (Sat. lunch - Sun. lunch) will be provided for this guided outing.

Anyone interested in arriving Friday evening or staying Sunday night after the paddle are welcome to do so. Just let us know so we can send you more information regarding such. Not familiar with Hornbeck solo canoes? Visit [Hornbeck Boats](#) online. They are awesome boats, are paddled like a kayak and weigh 12-17 lbs. A real treat to paddle!



After we are all packed up we'll head to the put-in (about a 30 minute ride.) Once on the water we will paddle until we find a nice campsite. The loons are quite active this time of year and rather entertaining. Expect to hear much "loon laughter" while visiting this incredibly peaceful area. You'll want a pair of binoculars and a camera for sure!! The sun set glistening across the water and a misty morning sunrise can be rather tranquilizing.

Once our camp is set up we'll make a decision about what to do next. There are plenty of places to explore in this area and a few ponds nearby to "pond hop" to. There's even the possibility of a hike to the summit of a small peak affording views of the many ponds, lakes and mountains around this part of the Adirondacks. Expect to arrive back at our home-base location in Tupper Lake mid-afternoon on Sunday. Those interested in spending the night camping at our place on the Raquette River are welcome.
